



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

"People helping people" is the credit union philosophy. As a community credit union, we believe strongly in the power of education and in furthering the goals of our youth. Our Scholarship Program is designed to help students who demonstrate a desire and commitment to continuing their education.

You are eligible to apply for the Scholarship if you are a graduating senior who is a member of the Credit Union or you are a graduating senior living in Oakland County, Michigan. Other requirements include:

1. Current transcript showing a minimum 2.0 grade point average.
2. Acceptance into a community college, university or trade school.
3. Three letters of personal reference - only one can be from school staff.
4. A 300 to 600 word essay indicating why you should be the recipient of this scholarship.

Family members of Lakes Community Credit Union employees or Official Family are not eligible for the scholarship award.

Recipients are selected based upon a number of criteria including:

- Academic achievement
- Community involvement
- School involvement
- Work history
- Other outstanding achievements

When completing the essay, applicants should follow these guidelines:

- Place your name in the bottom left hand corner of the page
- The essay must be typed
- The essay must be grammatically correct and free of errors
- The essay should demonstrate an enthusiasm for higher learning, with commitment to furthering your education.
- There should be a short section about your money management skills.

There are four scholarships available, each worth \$500. They are one-time, non-renewable scholarships. Scholarship recipients will be awarded in April 2012.
